Wakefield District – Coalition Against Cuts

Joint union public sector workers action on 30th November was massive. Millions participated, with thousands demonstrating at local rallies, including 2,000 in Wakefield.

Workers are also defending our public services against decimation.

However, some trade union leaders have accepted the 'logic of the market' – that is, the so-called logic of cutting workers pay and conditions.

Likewise, New Labour leaders winge about 'Tory' cuts while voting for cuts in local council services. Indeed, not even one labour councillor voted against cuts anywhere. Their alternative is to call for support for slightly less savage New Labour cuts!

All of the main parties now serve the interests of concentrated finance capital and the richest minority elite. They do not intend to sort out the banksters and pirates who are to blame for wrecking the economy.

Wakefield district has been hit particularly hard. Those on job seekers allowance (JSA) have risen by 245%, one of the steepest increases in the country!

We need to step up the campaigns to build mass resistance. Only people power has the potential to defeat all the attacks on jobs and services.
